◆Joint Training for Local Community (July - October)

Targeting agencies taking part in the Regional Network System for the Child Maltreatment, CRC has been providing training programs for professionals in local area. The program includes issues on assessment, teamwork, and basic measures on child abuse and neglect. This year, we will be visiting Yamagata in July and Shiga in October!

◆Joint Training for Supervisors in Child Welfare Institutes(December)

This program is for professionals in child welfare institutes such as infant's homes, Children's homes, residential treatment centers for emotionally disturbed children, children's self-reliance support facilities, and mothers & children's homes. Through symposiums and group discussions, the program focuses on thinking about children's lives in social care.



Multi-agency cooperation is important in working with abused and neglected children and their families. CRC has been carrying out joint training programs for smoother collaboration in practice.

◆Joint Training for School Teachers and Children's Guidance Center Staffs (August)

The collaboration between educational facility and the children's guidance center is very important when working with school-aged children who are abused and/or neglected. Through lectures, symposiums, and group discussions, the trainee will recognize each other's role and will think together what we can do for the children.

◆Joint Training for Supervisors in Children's Guidance Centers and Child Welfare Institutes (January)

Collaboration between the children's guidance center and child welfare institute is essential throughout the child's support and their future. Although it seems you know about each other's profession well, there are many things you don't know about. Through lectures, group discussions, and case studies, trainees will gain more understanding of each other for a more effective teamwork.

Protecting Children from Maltreatment**



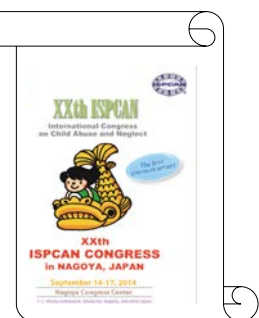
